Houstonopoly:

Design: plans, creation & implementation

6 custom three - dimensional Monopoly game pieces 4 to 5 feet tall - created from carved styrofoam, fiberglass, mixed media, and metallic paint

HOUville:

Design: plans, creation & implementation

10' tall x 20' wide Whoville themed freestanding facades were custom created for the live Holiday themed experience room.

Each piece was hand painted and cut on thick over-sized gator board with metal support system.

Arch entry ways, multiple Suess inspired buildings, and stage elements were installed..

Escape Room Experience:

Design: plans, creation & implementation

Series of custom three dimensional elements in wood and mixed media with working electronics and ifor clue activated result by guests.

Whimsical wardrobe of paper sculpture garments:

Design: plans, creation & implementation

Series of garments decorated with individually placed authentic string sale tags and hand-crafted paper art accessories -

Men's jackets, sweaters, & bombers. Women's bustiers, ball gowns, dresses, victorian mutton sleeved costumes, mod minis, sunglasses, belts, shoes & hand bags.

Aisle of Style:

Design: plans, creation & implementation

Perfectly proportioned pop-up shop. 10' X 10' painted floor with 3 - 10' foot double sided walls & embedded picture rails.

Installed for luxury home goods retailer for convention of specialty art, home & antiques.

The Tuileries reimagined in Washington DC:

Design: plans, creation & implementation

10' tall continuous walls of fresh white rose embellished painted lattice wrapped a living garden of earthly delights.

Installation surrounded the perimeter of the center to unveil the opening of the brand new Hermes Boutique in Washington DC.

20' live cypress trees, blooming citrus, white flowering plants, topiaries and a perfectly planted garden of fresh strawberry plants in carefully crafted painted planters were illuminated by tall lattice zinc pyramid columns. The magical garden disappeared overnight in time for the first day opening of the Luxury French retailer.

Neon & Silk:

Design: plans, creation & implementation

An illuminating solution was required for the staggered openings of a series of 350,000 square foot retail locations in Houston, Dallas & San Antonio. Neon sculpture artists Larry Flukinger & Clark Harrah created a series of artful pieces and towers installed

in every department of the retail location to color coordinate with custom made bright chinese silk obelisks & elements purchased for each location. The neon pieces were crated and re-used for each retail Opening in each city. Exhibitions of pieces by the artists coincided in art galleries simultaneously. The artists retained the custom pieces after the completion of the 3 city store project.
